

Heart Number Match File Folder Game

Print out the following pages onto printer card. Red or pink card works well, or you can use white card and ask the children to colour in the hearts. Cut out the hearts carefully.

Glue the dotted set of hearts randomly onto the inside of a file folder. Decorate with stickers or other decorations if you like.

Optional: Dab a small dot of PVA (white) glue or 3D paint on to each dot. Leave to dry. This makes the dotted hearts more interesting for children to feel and count.

If you can, laminate the other, numbered, set of hearts. Keep them with the file folder in an envelope or Ziploc bag.

To play, your child counts the dots on the file folder hearts and finds the matching numbered heart, placing it on top.
